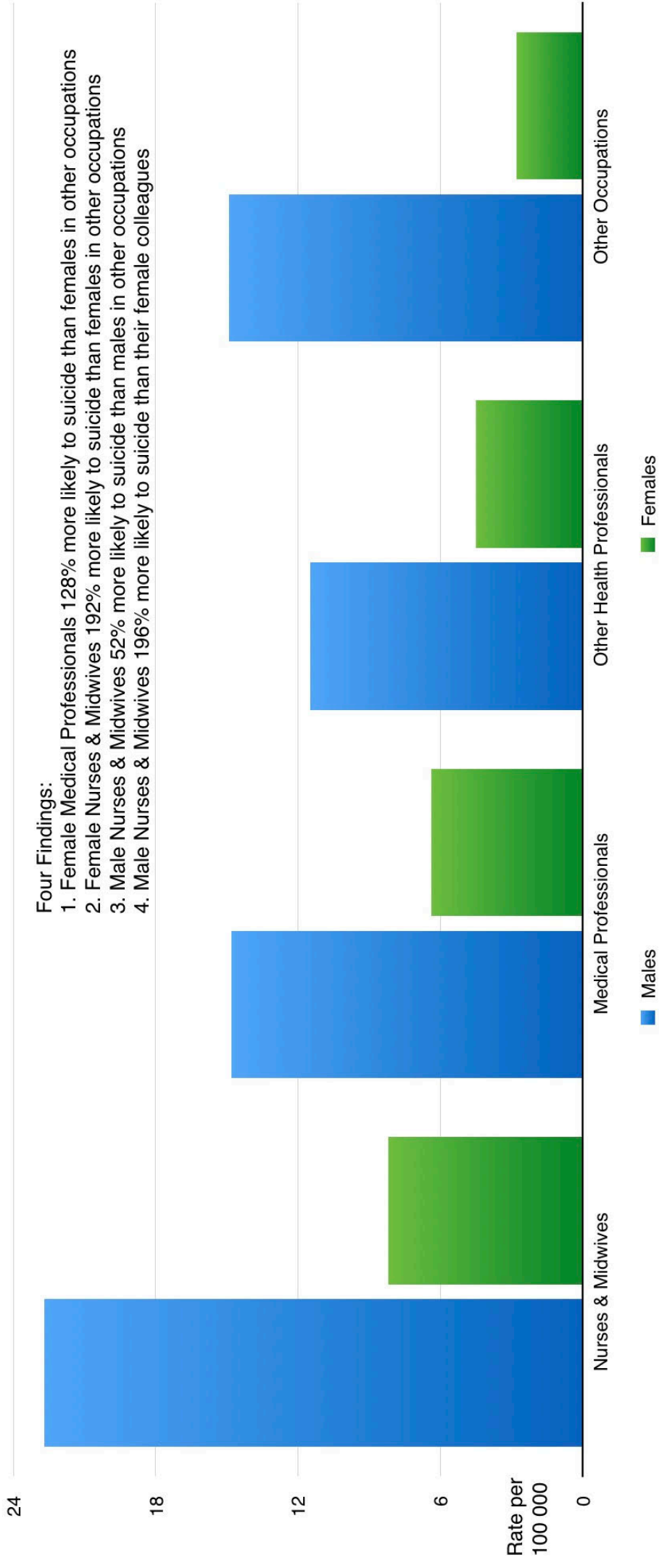


Age-standardised rates of suicide by employed adults aged 20-70 years, Australia, 2001-2012



Four Findings:

1. Female Medical Professionals 128% more likely to suicide than females in other occupations
2. Female Nurses & Midwives 192% more likely to suicide than females in other occupations
3. Male Nurses & Midwives 52% more likely to suicide than males in other occupations
4. Male Nurses & Midwives 196% more likely to suicide than their female colleagues
